Troubleshooting Guide

"Is yours not working?"

Issue	Solution
Your light is not on	 A. Make sure that your battery charge matches your path charge: > Does your positive path lead to the positive side of the battery holder. > Does your negative path leads to the negative side of the battery holder.
	Flipping your battery over is one way to solve this issue.
	B. Is there a gap in your path? This means you have a broken circuit. It must be closed.
	C. Are your positive and negative paths touching? They cannot touch! This means you have a crossed connection.
Your light is blinking on and off or is on inconsistently	Tape down the curled LED lights so that there is more pressure attaching the LED lights to the conductive tape.
